# How your support is improving environmental equity in Canada

In 1984 a committed group of Canadians established the Green Party of Canada, and we marked our 40th-anniversary last year. We had the honour of celebrating alongside one of our founders, Dr. Trevor Hancock. Reflecting on our history, Trevor reminded us that the ecological crises identified in the 80s persist today, with the looming threat of climate tipping points. While other parties maintain 'business as usual,' we remain unwavering in our commitment to prioritize both the planet and its people. Four decades on, the necessity of a strong Green Party in Canada remains as vital as ever.

Your support today helps elect and support Green MPs who champion crucial causes and put forward Green legislation. In 2024, we expect to see a historic piece of legislation sponsored by Green Party Leader Elizabeth May become law. Bill C-226 is the Fighting Environmental Racism Act.

In Canada, polluting industrial projects are more likely to be near Indigenous, Black and other racialized communities.

That's environmental racism.

C-226 marks a pivotal moment for environmental justice. The bill was first introduced by former MP Lenore Zann. Its revival and sponsorship by Elizabeth May aligns with her decades of advocacy and unwavering commitment to protecting vulnerable communities. It also exemplifies the Green approach of working together for the greater good. The bill is now in its final stages in the Senate, thanks to the backing of



Senator Mary Jane McCallum. When C-226 becomes law it will ensure that vulnerable communities will have the tools they need to protect their well-being.

Your contributions power the election of Green MPs. Those MPs drive change. We're making strides towards a fairer, greener Canada for everyone because of you.

#### WeDecide

# How your Green MPs are making an impact in the House of Commons

\$4.2 billion dollars would go a long way to fighting climate change and making life more affordable for Canadians!

Green MPs have an outsized impact in the House of Commons. Want proof? Look no further than the work of Green MP Mike Morrice. Mike ignited a nationwide conversation by introducing Motion M-92, calling for a windfall tax on excess profits of oil and gas companies.

The Parliamentary Budget Office evaluated Mike's motion, and confirmed this tax could provide Canada with an additional \$4.2 billion to help Canadians with the cost of living and prepare our communities for the challenges of climate change.

But that's not all...

In 2023, Mike made significant progress on ending legislated poverty for Canadians with disabilities. Greens secured over half of the amendments to the Canada Disability Benefit (CDB) bill that was finally passed in June 2023.

Sadly, after all of the advocacy of the disability community and the work of parliamentarians, the 2024 budget did not deliver on the CDB. The government limited the benefit to just \$200 per month, it won't start until July 2025 and eligibility will be very limited. This is unacceptable and Mike will continue to fight for a fully funded Canada Disability Benefit to meet the urgent needs of Canadians with disabilities.

Canada needs more Green champions in Parliament! Thanks to your donations in 2023, our Campaign School 101 - Campaign Foundations helped equip our members to run effective campaigns. With your continued support, we're excited to expand this program in 2024!
